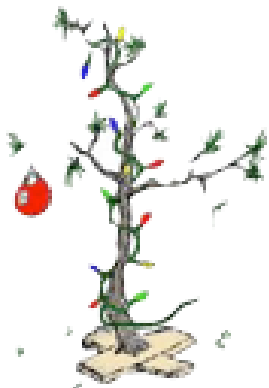

Please Help Us!

* If your child is absent, please notify the office by 8:30 AM. Absences will be unexcused until you call and verify the reason for their absence.

* Parents, if you drop your child off in the mornings, be sure he or she does NOT walk across the driveway! When in your car, please follow behind the bus line-up and drop them off at the door. After parking, please walk your child to the entrance doors or let them out at the gate in the playground fence to walk on the slab to the building.

* Bus Passes: Anytime a student is riding a bus to go home with a friend or childcare provider, a bus pass is required. Permission from the bus driver is also needed due to space limitations. Most buses will have room for an extra rider, but are never prepared to transport multiple friends to a location. If a child is having more than one friend going home with them, parents need to make transportation arrangements. Permission is needed from both individuals, receiving and sending.
